Step 1 What do you want to know about?

Step 2 Think of a word to describe your subject. Look the word up and check the subject category next to it.

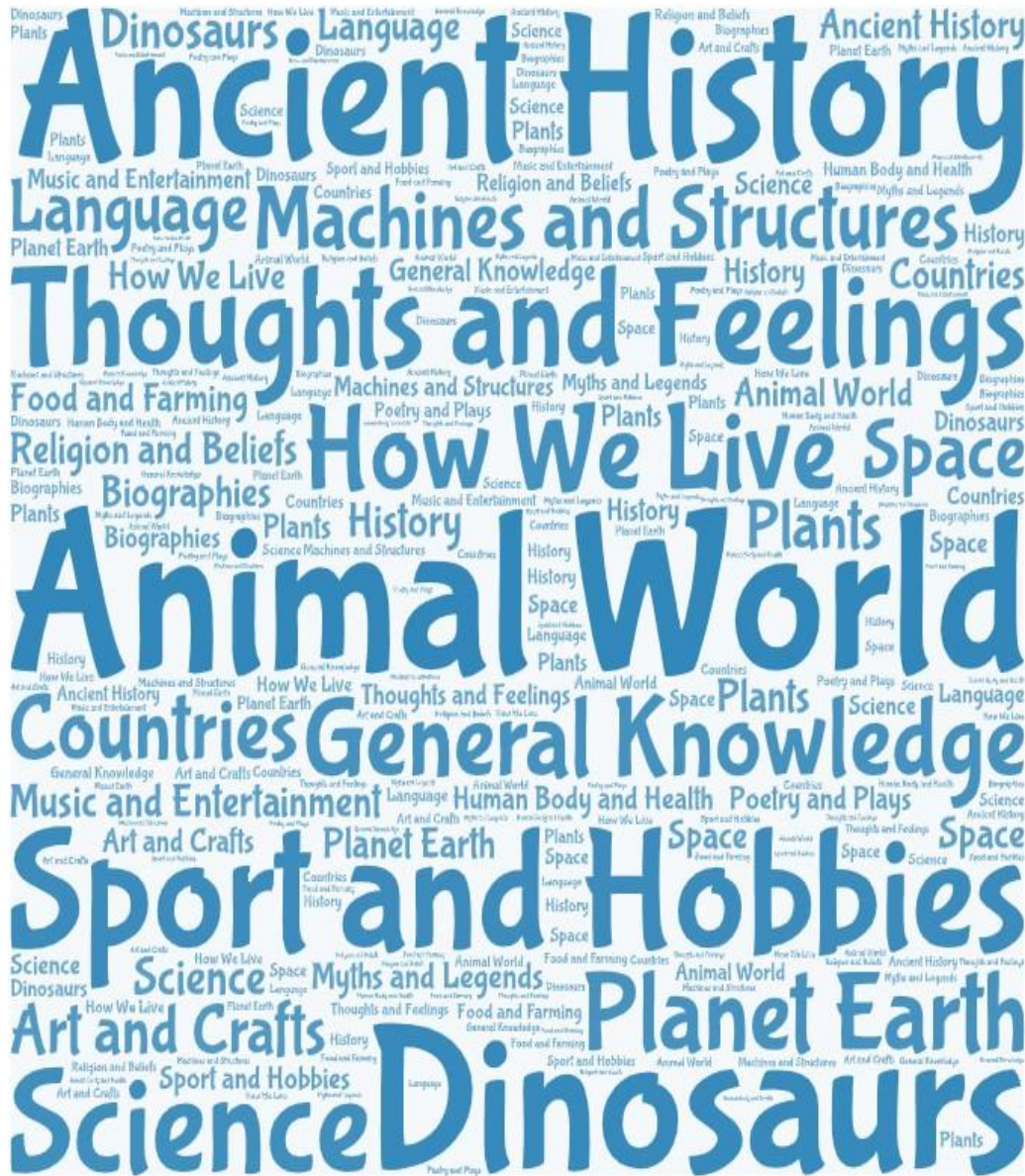
Step 3 If your word is not on the list, try to think of another word that means the same thing.

Step 4 Look for the subject category on the shelves.

Step 5 If there are no books on your subject in the library, ask for help.
